FUNCTION OF EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT CODES

The Function of Expenditure account codes describe the activities being performed for which a service or material object is acquired. In determining the function code, attention should be focused on the <u>specific activity being performed</u> and <u>not the program which will be benefited</u>. See the definition of program codes to further distinguish these two separate codes.

Student Transportation Services (4110-4190)

Activities concerned with conveying students to and from and between schools.

4110	<u>Transportation Administrative Services</u> Activities pertaining to directing and managing student transportation services.
4120	Regular Transportation Activities concerned with conveying students to and from home and school.
4121	Natural Disaster Transportation Temporary activities concerned with conveying students to and from home and another school, because their zoned school was destroyed by hurricane, tornado, fire, flood or other natural disaster.
4130	<u>Special Needs Transportation</u> Activities concerned with conveying special needs students to and from home and school. Pre-school special needs students should be included under this function code.
4131	<u>Transition-to-Work Transportation</u> Activities concerned with conveying special needs students to and from job sites during the school day.
4132	<u>Special Needs Mid-Day Transportation</u> Activities concerned with conveying special needs students to and from schools and other authorized locations during the school day.
4140	<u>Technical School Transportation</u> Activities concerned with conveying students to and from secondary technical schools during the school day.
4141	Mid-Day Transportation Activities concerned with conveying students to and from schools and other authorized locations during the school day.

4150	Extracurricular Transportation Activities concerned with conveying students on trips to athletic events, field trips, and other school-sponsored activities. Must be used with object codes (161) and (391) and program codes (4400) and (4500-4510).
4170	<u>Transportation Vehicle Maintenance Services</u> Activities involved in maintaining student transportation vehicles. It includes repairing vehicles, replacing parts, cleaning, painting, fueling and inspecting for safety. NOTE: Other school-owned vehicle maintenance costs should be recorded using (3500) – Vehicle Services or (1100) – Instruction for Driver Education vehicles.
4180	<u>Choice-related Transportation</u> Activities involved in providing choice-related student transportation required under the <i>No Child Left Behind Act of 2001</i> .
4181	<u>Head Start Transportation</u> Activities involved in providing student transportation related to the Head Start program.
4182	<u>Pre-school Transportation from Student Homes</u> Activities concerned with conveying non-special needs pre-school students to and from student homes and pre-school centers.
4183	<u>Alternative School Transportation from Zoned Schools</u> Activities concerned with conveying alternative school students to and from their zoned schools and alternative schools.
4184	<u>Magnet School Transportation from Zoned Schools</u> Activities concerned with conveying magnet school students to and from their zoned schools and magnet schools.
4185	<u>Magnet School Transportation from Student Homes</u> Activities concerned with conveying magnet school students to and from student homes and magnet schools.
4186	<u>Pre-school Transportation from Zoned Schools</u> Activities concerned with conveying non-special needs pre-school students to and from their zoned schools and pre-school centers.
4187	Alternative School Transportation from Student Homes Activities concerned with conveying alternative school students to and from student homes and alternative schools.
4188	Extended Day Transportation Activities concerned with conveying students after regular school hours.
4189	Homeless Transportation Activities concerned with conveying students who are classified as homeless.
4190	Other Transportation Services Student transportation activities that cannot be classified in the above account codes.

OBJECT OF EXPENDITURE COMPONENT

The object of expenditure component is used in the accounting system to identify the service or commodity obtained as the result of a specific expenditure. Object of expenditure codes are required to be used with function of expenditure codes when recording expenditure transactions.

The three (3) digit object of expenditure code in the accounting system will identify the following major categories:
